ADDITIONAL MATTERS ORDER

The Worshipful Timothy John Briden Master, Master of Arts Bachelor of Law Chancellor of the Diocese and Official Principal of the Right Reverend Peter Hancock, Lord Bishop of Bath and Wells, having sought the advice of the Diocesan Advisory Committee, hereby makes an additional matters order, applicable to the whole Diocese in respect of the temporary display of a "There but Not There" transparent installation in remembrance of the dead of World War I subject to the following conditions:

- (i) The church architect or surveyor shall approve the location and any fixing of the installation.
- (ii) The installation may be put in place during the month of November in each year and at other times authorised by the Chancellor
- (iii) Arrangements shall be made for the safe storage of the installation when it is not in use.

The above works may be undertaken without the permission of the Archdeacon.
